Checks you do Annually	
Check basement for dampness and leakage	
Check grading to ensure water flows away from the walls	
Check wooden structures for signs of termites

Test pressure relief valve in water heater	
Clean humidifier from any dirt it gathered during the year	
Check distribution board for traces of rust	
Check exposed wiring for damages	
Give your house a very deep clean	
Replace batteries in smoke detectors	
Vacuum your refrigerator coils	
from gathered dust	
Check extension cords for damages

Checks you do in Spring	
Check the exterior drainage	
Test garage door auto-reverse feature	
Clean up the exterior	
Test air conditioning system	
Repair damages on windows if any	
Check for water damages	
Inspect fire extinguisher	
Check trees for interference with electric lines	
Inspect roofing for damage	

Checks you do in Summer
Check grout in bathroom and kitchen
Inspect plumbing
Check for an insect infestation
Run water and flush toilets in unused spaces
Clean and repair deck/patio as needed
Clean out window wells of debris
Check for openings in electrical panel
Check and clean dryer vent

Checks you do in Autumn	
Flush hot water heater and remove sediment	
Get heating system ready for winter	
Turn off and flush outdoor water facets	
Get chimney cleaned, if you have one	
Test sump pump	
Check water softener, add salt if needed	
Check driveway/pavement for cracks	
Prepare air conditioning systems	

Checks you do in Winter	
Check for ice dams and icicles	
Test the electricity	
Tighten any handles, knobs and racks	
Check locks on doors and windows	
Look for any unusual flame movements	
Remove shower heads and clean sediment	
Deep clean and inspect the basement	
Check for leaks in dishwasher and sink	
Test smoke detectors
